



## **BIATHLON OFFICIALS ADVANCED COURSE**

**CFB Gagetown, New Brunswick – 3 and 4 December 2005**

### **INVITATION**

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#### **GENERAL**

An Officials Advanced Course has been sanctioned by Biathlon Canada to be hosted by Biathlon New Brunswick, with support by Biathlon Canada. The course will lead to qualification as an Advanced official for successful candidates. Officials from across Canada and the USA are invited to participate.

#### **COURSE DETAILS**

**Dates:** 3 and 4 December 2005  
**Timings:** 08:00 – 17:00 both days, with homework on Saturday evening  
**Location:** Building J-7, CFB Gagetown, NB  
**Registration Fee:** \$40.00 (Division or individual responsibility)  
**Instructors:** Ray Kokkonen and Rheal Laviolette

#### **PREREQUISITES**

All Canadian participants must be qualified as a Basic Level official with at least one competition in all functional groups and must be a member in good standing of Biathlon Canada through their division.

#### **REGISTRATION**

All participants must register by completing the attached registration form. The form must be received by the Biathlon NB office or Nathan DenHollander as soon as possible and not later than 25 November 2005. The form can be e-mailed and the registration fee can be paid at the course.

#### **ACCOMMODATION, TRANSPORTATION AND MEALS**

All candidates are financially responsible for their own travel, accommodations and meals. The course will be two full days and travel arrangements must be done accordingly - late arrivals and early departures would have a negative effect on the course. Lodging can be arranged for about \$100 per night at the new Days Inn Hotel in Oromocto.

#### **COURSE MATERIAL**

The necessary handouts, including a detailed timetable, will be issued at the start of the course. If candidates have a current Biathlon Canada Handbook, it should be brought to the course. Candidates without a Handbook will be able to purchase one at the course – please indicate on the registration form.

Successful candidates will receive the Silver Badge, the new logbook and a qualification certificate. The new officials name-tag is included in the registration fee and will be sent later by Biathlon Canada.
